



2019-2020 Federal Parent PLUS Loan Authorization for Undergraduate Students

The maximum amount that you are eligible to borrow from the Federal PLUS Loan program is based upon your student's costs of attendance, as determined by the University of Alaska Southeast, less any other financial assistance that has been, or will be, received for the period of enrollment.

PLUS Loans, like other types of financial aid, can be used only for educational expenses. Consequently, the proceeds from your PLUS Loan will be applied directly to your student's University account (bill). If the amount of the PLUS Loan disbursement exceeds the amount due on the student's account, the University will prepare a refund check. Per federal regulations, this check must be made payable to the parent borrower, unless we have specific authorization to release the funds to the student.
