Beginning Fall 2012, new regulations took effect which limits the amount of Pell Grants funds that you may receive over your lifetime. The maximum amount you can receive over your lifetime is limited to be equivalent of six years of full time semesters of Pell Grant funding. The amount you are eligible for each year is equal to 100%; the six-year equivalent is 600%. Students who have exceeded the 600% of their Pell Grant eligibility are not eligible to receive the Pell Grant. Students who may be close to the 600% of their Pell Grant eligibility may receive a reduced amount of Pell Grant.
