





Stay On Track Tuition Waiver	You have been awarded a Stay on Track Tuition Waiver because you indicated on your FAFSA that you were a Sophomore, Junior, or Senior. You must have a minimum of 30 cumulative credits, and be enrolled in 15 credits that go towards your program of study on the Financial Aid Census Date each semester to qualify for this Tuition Waiver. As a Tuition Waiver, the award has no cash value and is good towards tuition incurred only at the campus designated on the award.
Stay On Track Tuition Waiver	The tuition waiver amount listed on your award notice does not have a cash value, may not be used in conjunction with any other tuition waivers or awards that are specifically restricted to tuition, and can only be used for enrollment in University of Alaska Southeast courses.
