

CREDIT FOR MARITIME INDUSTRY CERTIFICATIONS/EXAMS

UAS students admitted to a degree program may be awarded credit by examination by completing a US Coast Guard approved final exam for the course in which credit is being sought. Mariners may also receive nontraditional credit by submitting a copy of their Merchant Mariner Credential or Training Certificate from a USCG/STCW approved training program.

- Students must be degree-seeking to receive credit for certifications.
- Grades are Pass/Fail and are not calculated in the UAS GPA.
- Credit received is not considered UAS residence credit.
- Credits will not be considered as part of the semester course load for financial aid calculations.
- UAS does not guarantee transferability to other institutions.
